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SURGERY INFORMATION (PAGE 2 OF 2)

INSURANCE AUTHORIZATION:

First, we will obtain prior authorization from your insurance company. This could take some time depending upon the type of insurance you have. Once authorization is obtained, we will contact the hospital to check for availability. You will then receive a phone call to notify you that your surgery has been approved and to coordinate an appointment date. *Please note that your surgery appointment is subject to change at any time. You will receive a phone call the day before your surgery to verify your surgery appointment.

PRE-ADMISSION TESTING:

You are required to do pre-admission testing before your surgery. This may include: blood work, EKG, chest x-ray, and a meeting with the anesthesiologist. This will need to be don't at the same hospital where you are scheduled to have your surgery. *Some people may be required to get surgery clearance from their Primary Care Physician, Cardiologist, Pulmonologist, etc.

PRE-OPERATIVE APPOINTMENT:

You will be scheduled for a pre---operative visit at the hospital where you will have your surgery.

Please bring the following items to your pre-operative visit:

- A list of your current medications (including dosages)
- A photo ID
- Your current insurance card(s) or claim numbers and adjusters name, if applicable
- A list of previous hospitalizations and surgeries
- · A list of any known allergies or sensitivities

BEFORE YOUR SURGERY:

- Do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery date.
- Do not take any medications the day of your surgery.
- You may require a brace, depending on your surgery. You will need to be fitted for your brace prior to your surgery. You will take the brace to the hospital with you the day of your surgery.
- Fill the medications prescribed by your physician (some physician may not write prescriptions until after your surgery)

•	STOP ALL BLOOD THINNERS AND MEDICATIONS CONTAINING ASPIRINOR ANTIINFLAMMATORIES AT LEAST
	7-10 DAYS BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED SURGERY (SEE LIST BELOW). Not stopping these medications will cancel
	your surgery appointment, and your surgery will be moved to the next available date. If you have questions
	regarding if you are allowed to take a certain medication, please call our office to ask prior to your procedure!
